

BLENDING BOARD CARDS:

These cards are designed to easily fit on a three-ring binder so you can flip the cards randomly and students can blend sounds together to make both real and nonsense words. These cards follow the [UFLI Foundations Scope and Sequence](#), but all sounds are shown, so you could print and use to follow any scope and sequence. I also added some beginning and ending blend cards to use! **Remember not to add cards to your blending board until you have explicitly taught the phoneme-grapheme connection!**
