

PLACE VALUE TO 120 TASK CARDS

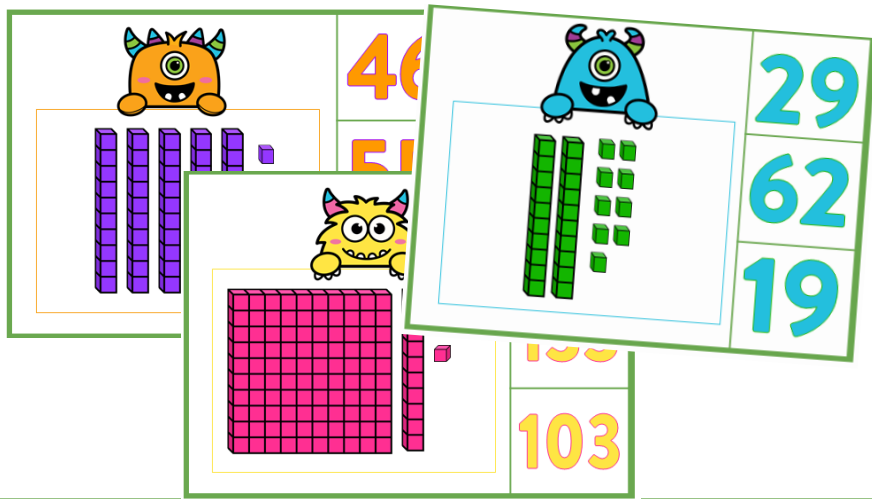
These place value cards are a great way for students to practice place value within 120:

- **Count & Clip:** here students will look at the base ten blocks below each monster. They will then count and clip the correct answer to the right.
- **Build & Compare:** here students will use base ten blocks to build the sets of numbers. They will then use an expo marker to put a $>$ $<$ or $=$ sign in the star.
- **Build & Add:** here students will look at the number in the first box. Then, they will read the rule and add $+1$ or $+10$ and write the answer in the box.
- **Build & Subtract:** here students will look at the number in the first box. Then, they will read the rule and add -1 or -10 and write the answer in the box.
- **Read & Color:** Here students will look at the number on the crayon box. Then, they will color in that number on the 100 grid.
- **Count & Write:** Here students will count the base ten blocks and write in how many tens and ones with an expo marker.

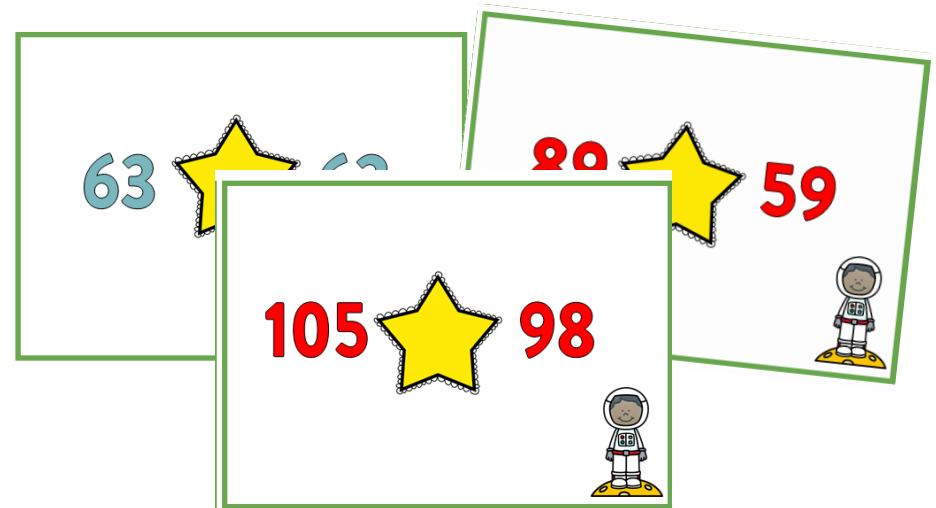
Please note: these cards should be laminated so they can be used with dry-erase markers over and over again.



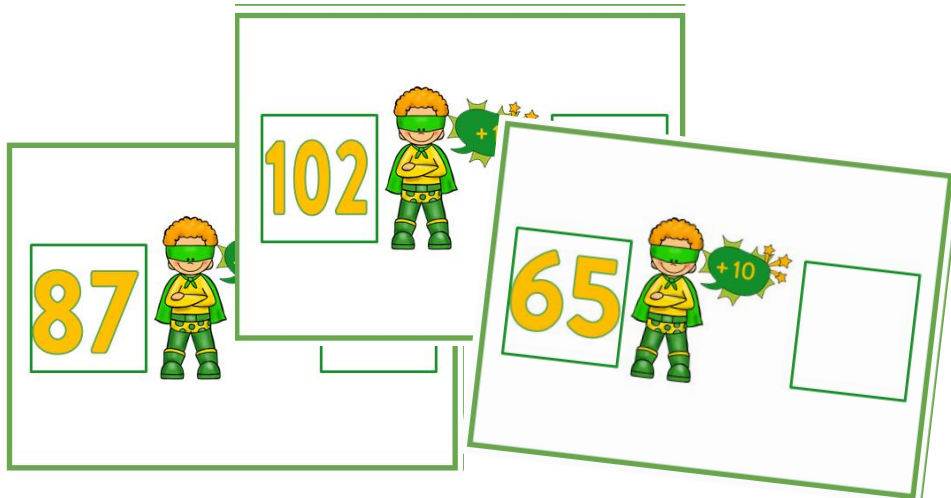

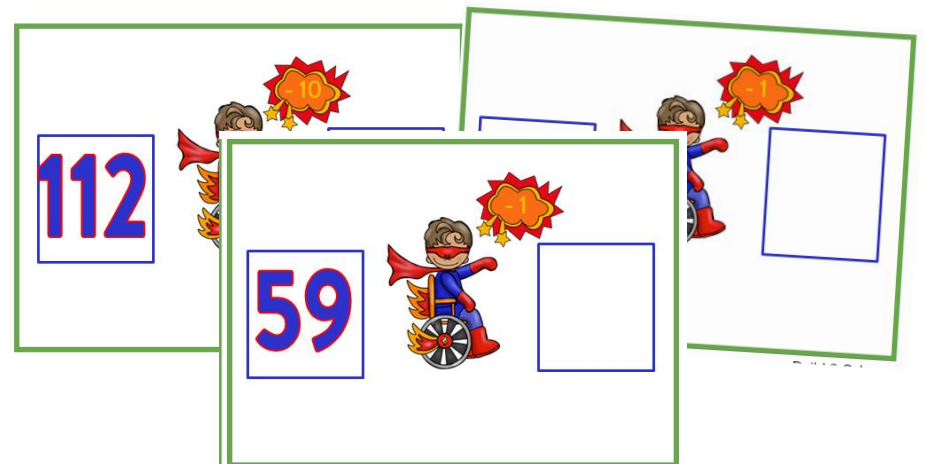

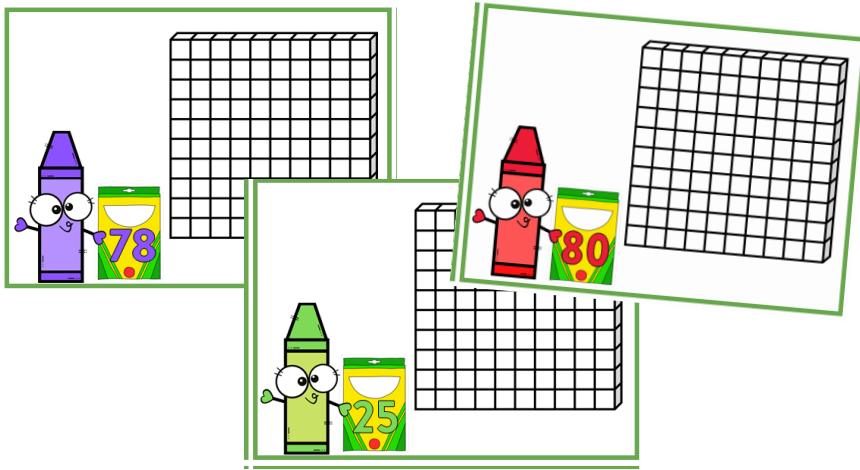
