

ROLL, SAY & CROSS OUT!

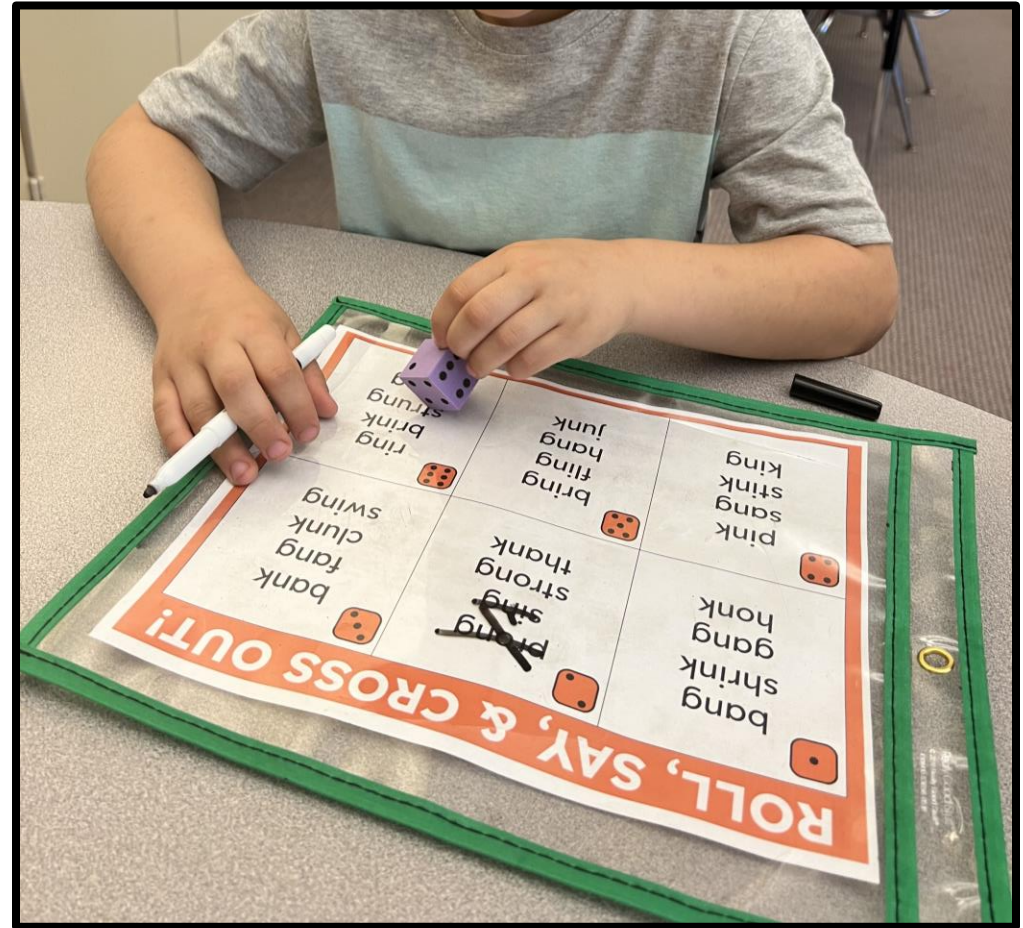
This simple print and play game has students practicing their fluency when reading words with different phonics patterns.

This type of game is a review game, so your students are expected to have learned the pattern/skill before they play this game.

With a partner, or independently, students will roll a die and find the column with that number at the top. Students will read the first word at the top of the list and cross it out with a dry-erase marker. Continue rolling, saying, and crossing them out.

I like to have these ready at the back table as a quick warm up while I get things ready for our small group learning!
