

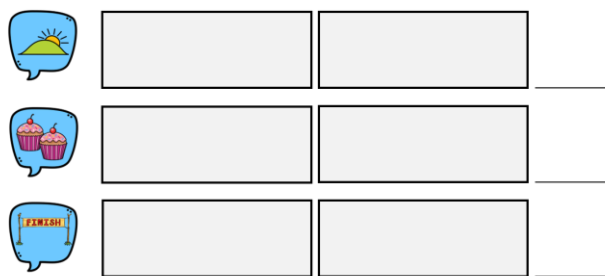
IN UNIT 13:

These phonics slides are meant to align with Level 1, Unit 13 of a FUN phonics program! These slides help guide your teaching and make your lessons more engaging.

This unit reviews all previously taught concepts. There are 130+ slides in this unit designed to explicitly teach students how to read and write multisyllabic words with suffixes (-e, -es, -ed, and -ing). This unit also teaches when to use -s and -es.

Here are some example slides:

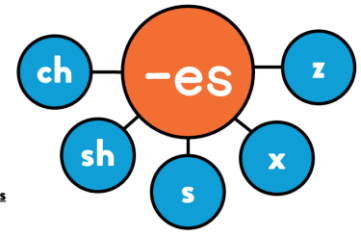
Let's Learn: When we spell multisyllabic words with suffixes, we don't just tap the sounds then spell. First, we segment the word syllable-by-syllable and tap the sounds in each word. Then we add the suffix.



Week 1, Day 2

- Students will learn to segment the syllables when spelling and then add the suffix.
- This reviews multisyllabic words and teaches them to add syllables.

Let's Learn: remember we can add the suffix -s and -es to nouns to make them plural and to verbs for subject-verb agreement. We use the suffix -es when words end with the following letters:



NOUNS:
boxes

VERBS:
I kiss the baby.
Molly kisses the baby.

Week 3, Day 1

- Students will explicitly learn when to add suffix -s and when to add -es to different words.
