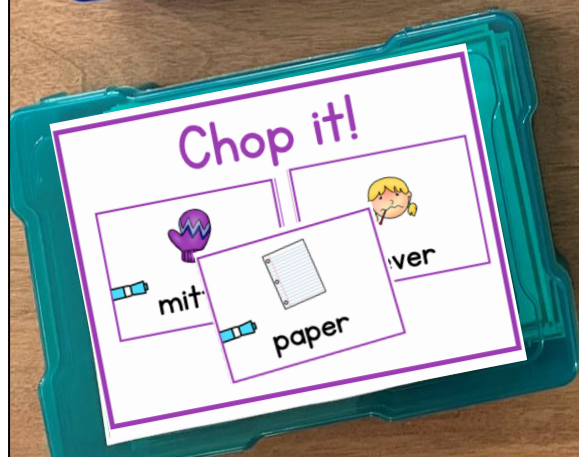
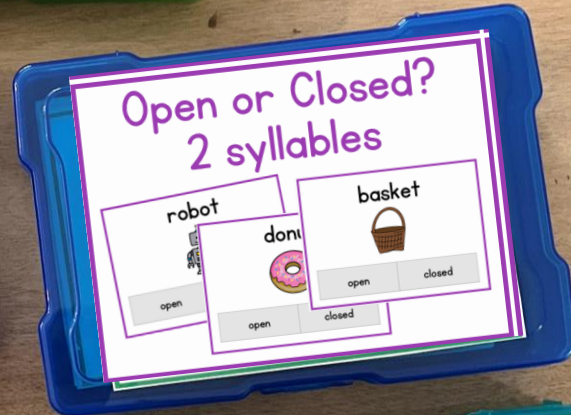
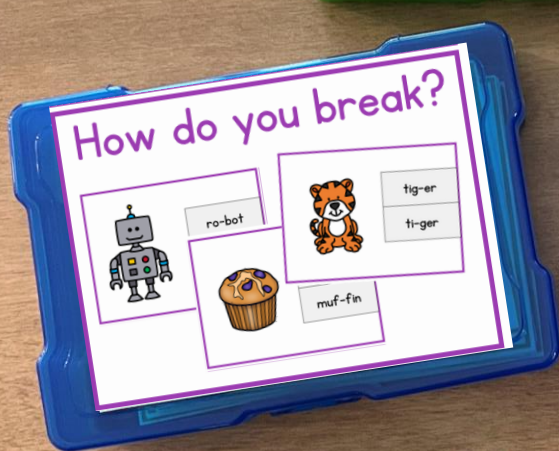


SYLLABLE TASK CARDS



These literacy center task cards are a great way for students to practice words reading and writing words with closed and open syllables. There are six different task card centers included in this unit:

- **Read & Find:** here students will read the word and circle the correct word
- **Open or Closed?:** here students will read the word and decide if it is a closed or open syllable. In the 2-syllable version, students will circle open if there is at least one open syllable in the word.
- **How do you break it?:** here students will read the words both ways and circle or clip the correct way to break the word.
- **Chop it!:** here students will use a dry-erase marker and draw a line to show where the word is separated into syllables
- **Finish it...** here students will complete the syllable to finish each word!

Please note: these cards should be laminated so they can be used with dry-erase markers over and over again.

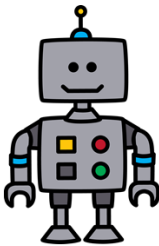

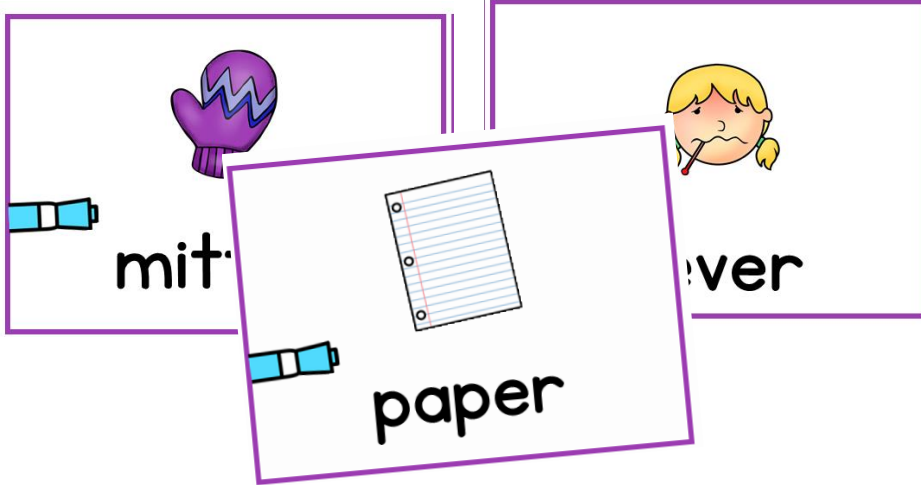
